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Your Words Produce

God Created with Words

- Psalm 33:6 & 9 By His Word, the heavens and all the host of them were made.
- Gen 1 God created with words.
 - o As He spoke, the worlds were created.
- **Heb 11:3** The worlds (*Aion*) were created by the Word of God:
 - o Aion: ages, eternal, generations, time, dispensation, continued duration past, present or future.
 - Faith enables us to perceive (*TCNT*) that the world came into being by the command of God (*Wey*).
 - It is faith that enables us to see (*Gspd*) that the whole scheme of time and space was created by the Word of God (*Phi*).
 - By means of faith, we perceive that the material universe and the Godappointed ages of time were equipped and fitted by God's word for the purpose for which they were intended.... (Wuest).
- What was the world made of?
 - o God made things you see out of invisible things—things that do not appear.
- God created out of His faith with faith-filled words.

We Create with Words

- God is a God of faith
 - o God releases His faith in Words.
- **Gen 1:26** We are created in His image.
 - When God created man, he placed His spirit in mankind with His breath.
 - God took something out of Him and gave it to Adam.
 - We are the only creatures on earth that can speak.
 - Therefore, when we speak, we speak part of ourselves out into the world.
 - We are the only creatures on earth that have a spirit.
 - Faith is in our spirit

John 1:1 Jesus is the Word and He came speaking words. o **John 6:63** Words are spirit and life. Spirit: Pneuma; breath, wind ■ Breath is life and life is spirit. ■ No breath—no life. Get a Faith Image to Receive Rom 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God. How is faith released? By speaking! o **Rom 10:8** But what saith it? The word is night hee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word of faith, which we preach; o God released His faith by speaking. • We release our faith by speaking. What is faith? o Faith is the image of what you are going to do. o Whatever you want to create, get the image on the inside of you and speak it forth. o **Eph 5:1** Be imitators of God. We framed our world the same way God framed His world. Your world is in your tongue. Whatever you want to create, get the image on the inside of you and start to speak it out and you will create it. o Get a faith vision of yourself as God sees you. o Speak His Word over your life to create His desire for you. ■ Mark 11:23 If you SAY & BELIEVE, you will receive it.

The Spiritual Law of Words

■ Col 1:14-15 God got an image of Jesus before He spoke His physical body into existence.

- The spiritual law of words has been working for you your whole life even though you did not understand it.
- Rule and law are two different things.
 - o Rules can be broken but laws are only confirmed.
 - We call rules set up by our country 'laws of the land', but there are really rules set up for us to obey.
 - o Laws of nature are there whether or not we like them or understand them and we can't break them, only confirm them.
 - Gravity is an unseen law working to keep your feet firmly planted on this earth.
 - Planting seeds into the ground produce only like kind.
- As there are laws of nature, there are also laws of the spiritual.
 - o If you plant a word, you get the effects of that word.
 - I call it the 'law of the seed'.
 - In the Bible, God's Word is call 'seed'.
 - Matt 24:35 Heaven and earth shall pass away, but my Words shall not pass away.
 - What you do on His Word, will last.
 - You can change the thing that you see by speaking the eternal Word.
 - **Ps 119:89** Forever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.

Creating Your Future

- You are presently living past words.
- Since we are spiritual beings, the words we speak have eternal consequences—good or bad!
- Your words are eternal and they go on and on and on.
- What about your future?
 - o If you want to know your future, how do you find out?
 - Fortunetellers?
 - No, you go to the Word of God.
 - **Josh 1:8** tells us not to let the Word depart out of our mouth.
- How do you set your future up?
 - o The same way God does, you speak it forth.
 - o **Rom 10:9** Your salvation was received by saying and believing.
 - What did you say about Jesus?
 - Your future depends on your words.

- God's Word is powerful and that power is resident in your spirit, production is increased from the heart, manifested through the forming of the tongue in words, which is released out of the mouth.
 - o For the power to be effective it must be spoken in faith
- God's powerful Word is not void, only our mouth is void of speaking His Word power.
- The breath of your spirit leaves your mouth and is sent out to do something.
 - o The problem is that our speech is too much of the world's speech.
 - What did you send out today?
 - o How many people did you give life to today?
 - What have you told your children today?
 - o What have you told your husband or family members today?

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From Heart Trouble to Tongue Trouble

A Heart of Fruit

■ Matt 12:33-37

- There is a correlation between the heart and the mouth in these scriptures.
- o The tree represents the heart and the fruit represents the mouth.
 - If your heart is good, your words will be good.
 - If your heart is evil and corrupt, your words will be evil and corrupt.
 - Vs. 33 Good: #2750 Expresses beauty as a harmonious completeness
 - Vs. 35 Good: #18 Benevolent, profitable, useful, to do good to benefit others, well doing.
 - Vs. 33 Corrupt: #4550 Sapron; rotten, worthless, bad
 - Vs. 34 Evil #4190 Poneros; Evil in a moral or spiritual sense; wicked, malicious, and mischievous.
 - Vs. 36 Idle #692 Inactive; unprofitable, not employed

■ Matt 7:17-18

- o The nature of the tree determines its fruit.
- o If the fruit (words) being produced are bad, the heart is bad.
- o The condition of our tongue determines the condition of our spiritual life.
- We may think we know the condition of our heart but the one sure unfailing test that the Bible tells us to check is what our mouth is speaking.
- The Lord said we can have what we say but unfortunately, we are saying what we have.
 - o Mark 11:23 Your words will produce a harvest of what you say.
 - This spiritual law will either change our impossible situation for the better or if applied incorrectly, hold you in deeper bondage and cause the impossible situation to worsen.


A Heart of Faith

- Matt 8:13 The centurion: "As you have believed, so be it done to you"
 - o If you believe right and speak right, it will work out for your good.
 - o If you believe wrong and speak wrong, it will work out to your detriment.

- What kinds of treasures are hidden in your heart?
 - The treasures in your tongue originate from your heart and are produced by your words.
 - Matt 12:34 Out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks.
 - o Hidden treasures are birthed in your spirit, multiplied in your heart, formed by your tongue, flows out of your mouth and create your future.
 - When you speak God's Words, faith is released.
 - When words are spoken and faith is released, these two components create material substance.
 - What substance have you been creating?
 - What is your heart and mouth full of? This is what you have been creating.

A Heart of Grace

- Psalm 45:1-2 A picture of our Lord.
 - Verse 1 My heart is overflowing with a beautiful thought! (Tay): I will recite
 my poem concerning the king (Rhm): may my tongue be like a pen of a
 gifted writer (Har).
 - Verse 2 You are the fairest (bright; to be beautiful) of humanity (Har): thy lips overflow with gracious (kind) utterance (Knox): so you are blessed by God forever (NEB).
- The first thing that is manifested showing the beauty and kindness of the Lord is His mouth/lips.
 - o Grace is manifested on the Lords lips.
 - o Luke 4:22 Gracious words proceeded out of Jesus' mouth.
- **Song of Solomon 4:3** Addressed to the bride
 - Scarlet lips = sanctified by the blood of Jesus
 - As a result of your lips being touch by Jesus' blood, they are lovely.
- Song of Solomon 4:11 Lips of the bride
 - o Milk & honey the Promised Land was flowing with milk and honey.
 - Promises flow from your lips as you confess His Word.
- **Ecc 10:12** The words of a wise man's mouth are gracious.
- Does milk and honey flow from your lips? Is your speech dripping with sweet honey?



A Heart of Fire

- **James 3:2** A perfect man, a perfect tongue
 - o A man who is able to control his tongue is mature.
 - o If you can control your tongue, you can control your whole life.
 - Perfect: Teleios; Adult, full grown, of full age, this image of fully completed growth, one who has attained his moral end, the goal for which he was intended, namely, to be a man obedient in Christ.
- **James 3** uses four examples of the mouth.
 - o A horse, the ships rudder, a fire, a deadly poison
 - The horse: verse 3
 - Represents strength and his whole body is able to be control by a small bit in his mouth.
 - Whoever controls the mouth controls the body.
 - o A ships rudder: verse 4
 - Controls the large ship from being shipwrecked in high winds.

- Our tongues control the course of our lives.
- Our tongues are like a rudder, which steers our destiny.
- o A fire: verse 5-6
 - Our tongue is a spark and can create a forest fire.
 - Fire destroys just as our tongues can destroy others and ourselves.
- o A deadly poison: verse 8 (Greek) fatal venom from a serpent
 - Unruly: Unrestrainable
 - Evil: *Kakos*: Recede, retreat in battle, one that is evil and as such, gets others into trouble but is willing and content to perish alone in his own corruption.
 - This poison will infect our whole body with fatal venom to destroy us.
 - What things can destroy our body? Sickness & disease
- Consider this very small member of our body, which is able to either destroy your whole life or bring blessings to your whole life.

What kind of Power are you Releasing?

The Curse

- **Prov 18:21** Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof.
 - Our tongue has power and produces fruit
 - o It has the power to produce life/good fruit or death/rotten, bitter fruit.
- **James 3:10** Out of the same mouth proceedeth blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not so to be. *KJV*
- Definition of a curse: A prayer or invocation for harm or injury to come upon someone; to wish anyone evil or ruin; to call upon divine or supernatural power to send injury upon someone.
- Two types of curses
 - o The curse of the law, which we have been redeemed from.
 - o The spoken word
- How are curses & blessings activated?
 - o Physical objects
 - Good: Communion 1 Cor 10:16 Cup of blessing
 - Bad: Occult objects
 - Words spoken/pronounced audibly and they continue on generation to generation.

Main Avenue Curses & Blessings Come

- **James 3:6** And the tongue is a fire, setteth on fire the course of nature; and it is set on fire of hell.
 - o Hells fire has your words when you speak evil.
- **James 3:9** We bless God and curse man who is made in God's image.
 - You are putting a curse on them like a witch would.
 - o **Prov 26:2** As the bird by wandering, as the swallow by flying, so the curse causeless shall not come.

- The forces that determine your life fall into two categories:
 - Visible and invisible
 - Physical & spiritual
 - The forces working in the invisible realm influence the events in the visible.
- Curses have power:
 - o Mark 11:12-14, 20-21 Jesus cursed the fig tree
 - This fig tree had the appearance of fruit without delivering the goods.

Self-Pronounced Curse

- We give Satan legal ground to attack us for our words.
- Rebecca told Jacob, "your curse be on me". Gen 27:13
- The Jewish people Matt 27:24-25
 - o No king but Caesar Gentile emperor, their destiny for 1900 years
 - o Give us Barabas violent man, criminal
 - Because of their words, violence has been against the Jews for thousands of vears.
 - What have you been pronouncing over yourself?

I am going crazy

I just can't take it any more. I give up.

I'm sick and tired

I seem to catch everything that comes down the pike

I hate my life. I might as well be dead.

I can never make ends meet

I'm so depressed

Nothing ever goes right for me

These kids are just awful

These kids are driving me crazy

- When you speak this way, you are inviting evil spirits to take them over.
 - o Rev. 12: 10 The accuser of the brethren
 - Accuser: *Kate/goreo*: Against/place of public speaking
 - The devil is an accuser.
 - He comes against you in a place of public speaking, before the Father, and accuses you of speaking against the Father.
 - Your words are legal.
- As we walk with God and learn to ask continually for His protection, we can expect His protection from outside sources as the threats are revealed to us.

- However, this tells me there is **one curse God cannot protect us from**.
 - \circ The one we pronounce on ourselves.
 - o Because we're not in agreement with what God says about us.
 - Words are powerful creation is still going on.
 - If we make no confession, we are left at the mercy of our circumstances.
 - If we make a bad confession, we expose ourselves to evil, demonic forces.
 - If we make a positive confession, we release the ministry of Jesus to help us.
 - He is the high priest of our confession **Heb 3:1**
 - When you confess God's Word by faith (genuine faith in the heart, humbly acknowledges its total dependence upon God) and you've met all the conditions of the promise, it's yours to possess.
 - o Faith comes by hearing and hearing and hearing (**Rom 10:17**).
 - If you don't have faith when you start confessing what God says over your circumstances, keep confessing anyway and you will develop your faith.
- **Rev 1:16** What is a two-edged sword?
 - o This sword came out of Jesus' mouth.
 - o Greek word for Two-edged: di-sto-mos; di=two stomos=mouth
 - o 4750 original Greek stoma: language; an opening in the earth; the front or edge of a weapon; face, mouth
 - o A sword with two mouths:
 - Rev 2:12
 - Heb 4:12
 - One sharpened edge of this sword came into being when the Word of God first initially proceeded from the mouth of God.
 - The second edge of this sword is added when the Word of God proceeds out of your mouth.
 - o It first passed through the mouth of God.
 - Second, the Word rose out of your spirit, invaded your understanding and proceeded out of your mouth and a second edge was added.

o God's mouth sharpened one side and your mouth sharpened the other side.

Curses We Pronounce on Others

- Satanic or soul power
 - Satan uses man's soul power and God performs the miraculous through man's spirit by the Holy Spirit.
 - Where there is a soul force, there is an evil force.
 - o Christians can speak curses over someone without realizing they're doing it.
 - Hatred, jealousy and an unruly tongue will hurt others.
 - **Job 31:30** Neither have I suffered my mouth to sin by wishing a curse to his soul.
 - **Solomon's Song 8:6** Jealousy is cruel as the grave and its flames as flames of fire.
 - **Heb 12:15** Bitterness brings defilement in our lives. It opens us up to the attacks of the devil.
 - o Evil speaking:
 - These words spoken against others are curses.
 - Words are eternal
 - Can't be taken back
 - New Words can be implemented
 - **James 3:6** says the tongue defiles the whole body.
 - They are channels through which demonic forces are directed against other members of Christ body.
 - It is not only the individual spoken about who is affected, the believer who is guilty of this kind of speech actually defiles both himself and the person to which he is speaking of.
 - Don't seek momentary gratification and allow ourselves to speak evil of someone.
 - When Christ intercedes for us, He sees our faults. His intercession for us is not based on condemnation but on our justification.
 - He does not establish our guilt but our righteousness. So don't bring charges with our mouth against God's chosen.

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Those Who Curse Us: Satanic or SOUL POWER

- You are being oppressed by that person's psychic power/force.
- Three consecutive steps:

- Condemn the tongue Isa 54:17 No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD.
- o Forgive the person who sent it and remit the sin (**John 20:23**). Whose soever sins ye remit....
- o Bless the person who sent it.
 - 1 Cor. 4:12 When insulting abuse is being heaped upon us, we invoke blessing upon those who are mistreating us. *Wuest*
 - 1 Pet 3:9 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing.
 - Reviling: Hurt the reputation of; smite with reports of bad words; speak evil of
 - Blessing: Speak well of; express good wishes; consecrate to divine use.
 - This will insure your spiritual purity before God.

Choose Blessings

- **Deut 30:19** I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live:
- **Prov 15:4** A wholesome tongue is a tree of life
 - o Perverse speech is a breach in the spirit.
 - *Perverse* = wrong use
 - Breach = leak
 - o God sends us blessings but it runs out of us as quickly as God fills us through our leaky mouths.
 - Time to pull in the reins on our tongue.
 - We must learn how to contain the blessings of God that are coming our way.

Repent→Revoke/Renounce→Replace with Godly words of truth.

 - o Words are power tools that can bring about change in your life.

 - It is our turn to speak out in faith and when we do, God will come for our words.
 - o God is moved by faith-filled words.

 - Knowing and believing are two different things.
 - **James 2:19** The devils believe and tremble.
 - Paul went beyond believing to knowing. He was confident that God was able to fulfill His Word to him.

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Why Our Words Are Powerful

Our words are powerful because we are powerful.

- o The breath of God within you makes you powerful.
- o You became a living, breathing, speaking life form, made from not just a lump of dirt, but also out of the heavenly substance of God—His breath.
 - You are both an earthly and heavenly substance.
 - Acts 17:28-29 We are God's offspring.
- o The positive words of the unbeliever are hope words. Our words as believers, are more powerful because they produce the God kind of faith faith to produce zoe life.
- If you are going to speak, you might as well speak words of life, and be productive with your words.
 - o Doing this, you will create a life worth living.
 - o God hears every faith declaration you make.
 - o God's Word will come to pass

Hold Your Tongue

- **Prov 10:19** Many words $= \sin$.
 - Where there is much talk there will be no end to sin, but he who keeps his mouth shut does wisely. BAS
- **Ecc 5:1-3** Come to the house of God to hear and let your words be few.
 - God wants our own words to be few because we are held accountable for them.
 - o Ecc 5:6 tells us that our mouth will cause our body to sin.
 - o If you don't mean it, don't say it.
 - The world of the spirit operates on what you say not what you mean.
 - o If you mean it and its slander, don't say it.
 - Prov 19:1 A perverted mouth is foolishness and backward to what God says.
- Gossip or Slander
 - o **Prov 26:20** Where no wood is, there the fire goeth out: so where there is no talebearer, the strife ceaseth.
 - The fire of hell is in gossip.
 - o Lev 19:16 Thou shalt not go up and down as a talebearer among thy people.
 - Don't ever show people in a bad light.
 - **Prov 20:19** He that goeth about as a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.
 - In addition, do not listen to people who make others look bad.
 - **Prov 18:8** What dainty morsels rumors are. They are eaten with great relish! -- Tay
 - When this dainty morsel is placed in front of you, do not be tempted to eat it because it is poison.

Lying

- **Prov 26:28** A lying tongue hateth those that are afflicted by it; and a flattering mouth worketh ruin.
- Ps 119:29 Remove from me the way of lying: and grant me thy law graciously.

■ Hasty Words

- o **Prov 29:20** Seest thou a man that is hasty in his words? There is more hope of a fool than of him.
- o A person with hasty words is worse than a fool, and the Bible has nothing good to say about the fool.
- o Num 20:7-12 Moses' hasty words cost him a dear price.
 - His hasty words cost Moses the privilege of leading the Israelites into the Promised Land.
 - **Psalm 106:32-33** The people provoked Moses' spirit and he sinned with his mouth.

We need "WORD" Power

- The things you hear and see affect what you say.
 - o **Ps 101:3** I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes:
 - o Put God's Word before your eyes daily.
 - Ps 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
- **2 Tim 3:16-17** "All Scripture is given by inspiration of God..."
 - o In the Greek, this text literally means the Scriptures were "God-breathed".
 - 2 Peter 1:20-21 The Scriptures were spoken and written by men who were inspired by the Holy Spirit.
 - God used their own personality, intellect, language, and style but the Holy Spirit supernaturally kept them from error.
- The channel that the Word of God goes through to become revelation:
 - You hear the Word
 - o Your mind picks the Word up as knowledge
 - o The Word goes into your spirit for assimilation and meditation
 - o It is then downloaded to the heart as revelation and understanding
 - o It is then given back to your mind as truth and faith for you


The Brain Machine

- Brain is like a computer and we have been programmed.
 - o We have been trained by our five senses.
 - o Thoughts of the enemy injected through the five senses.
 - o **Prov 3:5** Lean not with your own understanding/fives senses/reasons.
 - o We must be reprogrammed by renewal of the mind.

Rom 8:5-8

- Wuest translation: "For those who are habitually dominated by the sinful nature put their minds on the things of the sinful nature, but those who are habitually dominated by the Spirit put their minds on the things of the Spirit. For to have the mind dominated by the sinful nature is death, but to have the mind dominated by the Spirit is life and peace; because the mind dominated by the sinful nature is hostile to God, for it does not marshall itself under the command of the law of God, neither is it able to. Moreover, those who are in the sphere of the sinful nature are not able to please God."
- o Natural mind cannot think like God and cannot please God.
- Thoughts come in the brain from three places:
 - o God thoughts-truth and life
 - o Devil thoughts-from evil spirits in opposition to God
 - o Five senses-enmity with God because trained by the world

God's Thoughts = light = Productive, life, blessing, success, health



Worlds thoughts = darkness = Non-productive, destruction/ruin, curse, death, appearance of success only

The question is what are you ministering to others and where is your source coming from?	

We Need Holy Ghost Power

- We have seven openings in our head.
 - o 2 eyes, 2 ears, 2 nostrils, 1 mouth
 - o The one opening causes more problems than the other six put together.
- Since the tongue cannot be tamed by man, the taming of the tongue needs to be done with spiritual power: The Holy Ghost
 - o **James 3:7-8** says the tongue can no man tame. Only the Holy Spirit can do that.
- As a cruise liner needs a pilot to come on the ship, we need a pilot also.
 - The Captain needs to allow the pilot to dock the cruise liner or else it could crash.
 - We need the Holy Spirit to help us pilot our lives or else we will crash.
- The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Truth and the Spirit of Faith
 - o As you yield to Him, He will direct the course of your rudder, the tongue.
- When untamed, the tongue is deadly poison.
 - Ps 57:4 "My soul is among lions: and I lie even among them that are set on fire, even the sons of men, whose teeth are spears and arrows, and their tongue a sharp sword."
 - o As the lion cannot tame himself, so our flesh cannot tame our mouth.
 - The Holy Spirit is the lion trainer.
 - As it is possible to train a lion, it is possible to train your mouth.
 - The Holy Spirit trains us in the language of grace, mercy, and love.

I've Got the Power

- We get the impression there is something <u>we</u> can do to withstand the flesh.
 - You cannot do anything your only hope is to put on Christ and be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might by allowing the Holy Spirit access to your tongue.
- **Eph 6:10** "Be strong in the Lord"
 - o This power is locked inside the Lord. You cannot get it anywhere else.
 - o **Power:** Kratos; Demonstrated/manifested power, you can see it.

- The baptism of the Holy Ghost connects us to the mighty arm of God (power of the universe).
 - o Luke 24:49 endued with power
 - o Acts 1:8 Ye shall receive **power**
 - Acts 2:1-4 Day of Pentecost ... began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Why Speak in Tongues?

- Mark 16:17 God says to speak in tongues.
 - The more we pray in the spirit, the more of <u>God's power</u> is evident in our life:
- We are speaking to God
 - When we pray in the Holy Ghost, we are speaking to God. Our human spirit is in touch with Almighty God.
- We are communicating the mysteries up to the throne room of what Jesus is to us and through us.
 - 1 Cor 14:2 For he that speaketh in an unknown tongue speaketh not unto men, but unto God: for no man understandeth him; howbeit in the spirit he speaketh mysteries.
 - o Weymouth's translations: "He speaks divine secrets hid in God"
 - The Holy Spirit is causing the mysteries and the divine secrets recorded in the Word to come alive in your spirit.
 - Helps the Word of God come alive in your spirit.
 - The bible is words written on a piece of paper but when they come alive in your spirit, look out devil.
- We are calling forth parts of God's plan we do not even understand with our natural mind.
 - Its one thing to believe "by His stripes I am healed" but it is another thing to have that mystery born in you to such a degree that faith wells up in you.



- It brings our tongue under subjection to the spirit
 - o First step to yielding our members to God
 - o If we can yield the most unruly member, we can yield any member
- **Rom 8:26** The Holy Spirit helps us to produce results from our prayer life when we are unable to get results because of the limitations imposed on us by the flesh.
 - The Holy Spirit helps us to walk out of a life dominated by the flesh into a liberated walk of power.
- Enables us to pray for the unknown
- The Holy Spirit can pray through us for things we know nothing about.



The Reason for Your Tongue

My Mouth was Made for a Good Confession

- **1 Timothy 6:12-13** God witnessed a good confession from Jesus in front of Pontius Pilate.
 - o **Mark 15:2** And Pilate inquired of Him, Are you the King of the Jews? And He replied, It is as you say.
 - O John 18:36-37 Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence. Pilate therefore said unto him, Art thou a king then? Jesus answered, Thou sayest that I am a king. To this end have I been born, and to this end am I come into the world, that I should bear witness unto the truth. Every one that is of the truth heareth my voice.
 - Matt 26:62-65 Jesus said just enough to get himself crucified.
 - Acts 8:32 Like a sheep He was led to the slaughter, and as a lamb before its shearer is dumb, so He opens not His mouth.
 - Jesus didn't try to defend Himself
- **Heb 10:23** Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for he is faithful that promised.
 - o Profession is done with the mouth.
 - o Faith is with the mouth.
- **Luke 1:5-65** The angel of God smote Zechariah with dumbness.
 - o Zechariah had to be kept silent in order for John the Baptist to be born.
 - o The Children of Israel had to be silenced while marching around Jericho or else they would have spoiled God's plan of victory for them.

My Mouth was Made for Blessing

- Launch the Word into your life and others lives via your mouth.
- Prosperity is produce by your lips and you can't operate your faith unless you operate your mouth correctly.
 - o Your lips produce your salary—not your job

- Eph 4:29 Let no foul *or* polluting language, *nor* evil word *nor* unwholesome *or* worthless talk [ever] come out of your mouth, but only such [speech] as is good *and* beneficial to the spiritual progress of others, as is fitting to the need *and* the occasion, that it may be a blessing *and* give grace (God's favor) to those who hear it. AMP
 - o Our lips are to give grace to others
- Rom 14:19 Edify Others
 - o James 3:11 Your words must be a fountain of sweet water not bitter.
 - Get rid of the mixture.
- **Col 4:6** Let your speech be always with grace, seasoned with salt
- Col 3:17 And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

My Mouth was Made to Glorify God

- **Ps 16:8-9** I have set the LORD always before me: because he is at my right hand, I shall not be moved. Therefore, my heart is glad, and **my glory rejoiceth**: my flesh also shall rest in hope.
 - o David quotes this.
- Acts 2:25-26 For David speaketh concerning him, I foresaw the Lord always before my face, for he is on my right hand, that I should not be moved: Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope:
 - Peter quotes David.
 - Our tongues are our glory.
 - God gives us a tongue to glorify Him and this is the ultimate reason for our tongue.
 - We fall short of the glory of God when we misuse our tongue and don't live to glorify Him with this member of our body.
 - Rom 3:23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;
 - **James 3:6** the fire in the tongue of the natural man comes from hell
 - Acts 2:1-4 the fire in the Spirit filled man comes from God.
- Eph 5:17-20 Speaking Psalms, singing hymns, making music, giving thanks.
 - o It is a sin to be drunk with wine, but not to be filled with the Spirit is also sin.
 - The outcome of being filled with the Holy Spirit is using your mouth in a positive way and not a negative way.

My Mouth was Made to Praise God

- **Ps 71:24** My tongue also shall talk of thy righteousness all the day long: for they are confounded, for they are brought unto shame, that seek my hurt.
- Ps 34:1 Bless the Lord at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth.
- **Heb 13:15** By Him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually that is, the fruit of our lips giving thanks to His name.
 - o You do not get into the gates to praise God without thanksgiving on your lips.
 - Hosea 14:2 Take with you words, and turn to the LORD: say unto him, Take away all iniquity, and receive us graciously: so will we render the calves (sacrifice) of our lips.
 - Hosea 14:2 Take with you words and return to the Lord. Say to Him, Take away all our iniquity; accept what is good and receive us graciously; so will we render [our thanks] as bullocks [to be sacrificed] and pay the confession of our lips. AMP
- **Ps 89:1** I will sing of the mercies of the LORD forever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.
- **Eph 5:4** Let there be no filthiness (obscenity, indecency) nor foolish *and* sinful (silly and corrupt) talk, nor coarse jesting, which are not fitting *or* becoming; but instead voice your thankfulness [to God].

-	Ps 150:6 Let everything that hath breathe praise the Lord.

Does Jesus have a Good Confession about Me?

- If Jesus does not have a good confession He will be silent, but the devil will have a lot to say.
- **Heb 3:1** Wherefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our profession (*saying the same thing*), Christ Jesus;
 - o Jesus is the High Priest of our confession not our <u>unspoken faith</u>.
- **Heb 4:14** Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our profession.
- **Heb 10:23** Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for he is faithful that promised.
- Whom is God confessing us before?

- The Angels of God: Luke 12:8-9 Also I say unto you, whosoever shall confess me before men, him shall the Son of man also confess before the angels of God: But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.
- God the Father: Matt 10:32-33Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father, which is in heaven. But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven.
 - Rev 3:5 He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Do I have a Good Confession for Jesus?

- Matt 12:34-35 ... For out of the fullness (the overflow, the superabundance) of the heart the mouth speaks. The good man from his inner good treasure flings forth good things, and the evil man out of his inner evil storehouse flings forth evil things.
- Matt 18:18-19 Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again, I say unto you, that if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father, which is in heaven.
- **John 6:63** It is the spirit that quickeneth (*makes alive*); the flesh profiteth nothing: the words that I speak unto you, they are spirit (*Pneuma*), and they are life
 - When you speak, you are breathing out spirit, breath, life, something that is alive, *Pneuma*
 - o Put life out in the atmosphere where you are.
 - o Words are like tools to build your world.
 - Build your victory with words
 - Your words are tools to build and tools to demolish.
 - o A King decrees a thing and it is established.
- **Psalm 126** The Israelites wept when they saw their promised land desolate after years of being in captivity in Babylon.
 - Ps 126:5-6 Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy. He who goes
 out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying
 sheaves with him. NIV
